NCTB PRESS RELEASE

The National Congress of Trade Unions of The Bahamas (NCTUB) was formed on November 10th, 1995, under the Presidency of Dr. Leroy "Duke" Hanna who was also the President of the Bahamas Musician and Entertainers Union. The preamble of the Constitution and the objectives stated in part that the establishment of the Congress is an expression of the hopes and aspirations of the trade union and unionized workers of The Commonwealth of The Bahamas. An organization that is a pillar of the Bahamian way of life with a future as glorious as our past, whose motto is "Uniting Workers Vision for a Better Bahamas", the NCTUB encourages trade union leaders to work tirelessly towards solidifying trade unionism in the workplace.

The NCTUB embraces all free and democratic trade unions and employee associations operating in The Bahamas, and exists to enhance unity among all workers and to promote this unity by the pooling of resources, information expertise, and the active promotion of collective investment and social, cultural and economic development.

The registered office is presently, located at Horseshoe Drive and Carter Street, Nassau Bahamas.
